- denotes first-aid stations, which take early medical action in order to avoid high-concentration of the injured at hospitals and overloading the hospital functions. The doctors determine the priority of the injured and sick (triage), provide first-aid to patients with minor or moderate symptoms, and transport serious patients to hospitals. (5 locations)



### NTT Disaster Emergency Message Dial

This service can be used for communication between friends and family to confirm each other's safety.

- Phones that can use the service: Ordinary NTT phones, public phones, mobile phones, smartphones.
- Message recording time: Less than 30 seconds per message.
- Number of saved messages: 1 to 20 messages per phone number.
- Message retention period: For the duration of the service.

#### How to record/playback message

When recording: **171** (press 1, then 7, then 1)

When playing back: **2** (press 2)


Dial the phone number of the person you want to contact with the area-code of the disaster-stricken area.

## Tsunami Danger Zones (designated by Aichi Prefecture)

Tsunami Danger Zones are areas where there is risk of death or injury to residents in case a massive tsunami occurs. Aichi Prefecture designated these areas on July 30, 2019 based on the Special Provisions on the Act on Regional Development for Tsunami Disaster Prevention, in order to prevent human casualties due to tsunami.

In Kariya City as well, the same areas set and announced to have "Potential Tsunami Flooding" on November 26, 2014 by Aichi Prefecture, have also been designated as "Tsunami Danger Zones".

This map shows the standard water level (\*) for each 10 m mesh of the Tsunami Danger Zones in color coding, as well as a guide for the appropriate evacuation height in case of tsunami. (A model for 10 m mesh cannot be made for rivers and waterways with widths of less than 30 m as they are not connected to river channels, so they are not color coded, but as there is still possibility of flood from these rivers, caution is required) There are no designated Tsunami Special Danger Zones in Kariya City.

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### What is Standard Water Level? (\*)

This is the water level obtained by adding the amount of water level rise (raising height) when the tsunami collides with buildings, etc. to the flood depth in the expected tsunami inundation in the past.

Only the flood depth was shown in the expected tsunami inundation.
